# Korean Language Course

The Regular Program consists of six levels from level 1 to 6.

- 4terms per year(Spring/Fall-10weeks, Summer/Winter-8weeks)
- 5days a week, total 200 hours of lesson is provided
- Students can practice authentic Korean as they participate in various activities
- Provide a variety of Korean culture including taekwondo, traditional percussion quartet, K-pop, and dance, and so on.
